Hispanic and Latino refer to ethnicity, culture, and identity rather than skin color, race, or other physical features.

Exploring the Difference Between Hispanic and Latino Identities: The use of the term "Hispanic" in the recognition of the month is not without acknowledgment.

- While Hispanic and Latino are often used interchangeably, they have different meanings.
- **Hispanic**, which derives from the Latin word for "Spanish", refers to individuals who are Spanish-speaking or have a background in a Spanish-speaking country.
- **Latino** refers to those who are from or have a background in a Latin American country, this includes those who speak a Latin-based language.
